



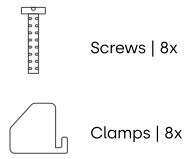
Getting started

To get started, unpack the box and verify that the following content is included.

C. Power adapter



D. Mounting brackets



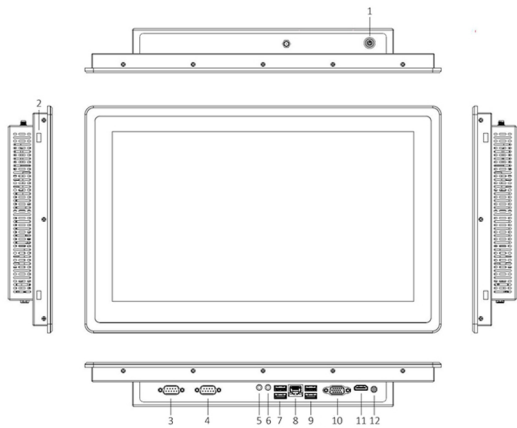
E. Cable clips

Connecting the hardware



1. On/OFF power button
2. Mounting brackets fixation
3. COM 1 (supports RS232)
4. COM 2 (supports RS232/RS485/RS422)
5. AUX/Audio in
6. AUX/Audio out
7. USB 2.0 port x 2
8. RJ45 LAN port (1000 mb/s)
9. USB-A 3.0 x 2
10. VGA output
11. HDMI output
12. 12V DC port

Device quickstart

1. The AIO comes with Ubuntu pre-installed and is set to turn on automatically when connected to power, making it immediately ready for use via the touch interface.
2. (Optional) Connect ethernet cable to the RJ45 LAN port (9).
3. (Optional) Connect external speakers or headphones to the AUX output (7) and microphone to the AUX input (6).
4. (Optional) Connect a mouse, keyboard or other PC peripherals to the USB ports (8, 10).
5. (Optional) Connect additional displays via VGA (11) or HDMI (12).

Panel mounting

1. Place the display into the designated cut-out area, ensuring the edges of the display align precisely with the edges of the cut-out. Make sure the cut-out is neither too small nor too large and account for the thickness of the display.
2. Attach the fixed screws from the back of the panel onto the screw interface on the side of the display.
3. Tighten each screw firmly so that the all-in-one display is securely attached to the wall or panel.
